Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

March 13, 2017

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Phil Hinds at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Mayor Phil Hinds, Council Members Ernie Blackford, Joseph Knop, Jennifer Sorenson, and Jory Delinger, Town Attorney Phil Willoughby, Town Treasurer Lexi Erickson, Lieutenant Josh Bjorklund, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Dan Adcock, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Town Engineer Shane Porter and Chief of Police Tom Laughrey were excused.

Mayor Phil Hinds led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Joseph Knop to approve the agenda with the addition of 5A – Approval of Building Permits #4297 & #4298. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting on February 27, 2017, were presented for approval. Motion was made by Joseph Knop and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF DEPARTMENTAL MONTHLY REPORT: The Treasurer report, Police report, Fire report, and the Public Works report were presented to the Governing Body in writing. Motion was made by Joseph Knop and seconded by Ernie Blackford to approve the departmental monthly reports. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #2-2017: An Ordinance Adopting and Approving a Franchise Agreement with Bresnan Communications, LLC. Third and final reading. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood read Ordinance #2-2017 by title. Motion was made by Jory Delinger and seconded by Jennifer Sorenson to approve Ordinance #2-2017 on third and final reading. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION #1-2017: A Wyoming Department of Transportation Resolution for Financial Assistance on Highway Maintenance. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood summarized Resolution #1-2017. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve Resolution #1-2017. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSES: Business License applications for Exploding Pill Taxidermy, Doggie Stylz Grooming, and Hooch's Arcade Game were presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Joseph Knop to approve the Business Licenses for Exploding Pill Taxidermy, Doggie Stylz Grooming, and Hooch's Arcade Game. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUILDING PERMIT: Building Permit applications #4297 and #4298 were presented to the Governing Body for approval. The applications were for new construction and a basement finish. Motion was made by Jennifer Sorenson and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve permits #4297 and #4298. Motion carried.

BILLS FOR APPROVAL: Bills were presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Joseph Knop and seconded by Jennifer Sorenson to pay all bills and draw treasury upon the same. Motion carried.


Public Works Director Dan Adcock stated that at this point, there aren't any plans to pave it but that they can come and fill in the potholes.
