Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

June 26, 2017

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Philip G. Hinds, at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Mayor Philip G. Hinds, Council Member Ernie Blackford, Joseph Knop, Jennifer Sorenson and Jory Delinger, Town Attorney Phil Willoughby, Town Treasurer Lexi Erickson, Chief of Police Tom Laughrey, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Dan Adcock, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Town Engineer Shane Porter was excused.

Mayor Hinds led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting on June 12, 2017, were presented for approval. Motion was made by Jennifer Sorenson and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #4-2017: An Ordinance for the Amendment of the FY 2016-2017 Budget. Third and final reading. Motion was made by Joseph Knop and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve Ordinance #4-2017 on third and final reading. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #5-2017: An Ordinance for the FY 2017-2018 Budget. Third and final reading. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Jennifer Sorenson to approve Ordinance #5-2017 on third and final reading. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSE: Business License Application for J & G Landscaping was presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Jory Delinger and seconded by Joseph Knop to approve the business license application for J & G Landscaping. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUILDING PERMITS: Building Permit application #4321 was presented to the Governing Body for approval. The application was for new construction. Motion was made by Jennifer Sorenson and seconded by Ernie Blackford to approve permit #4321. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: During public comments, Laura Johnson, 631 Platte Park Road, stated that she wanted to thank the Town for the new ordinance that was passed allowing fire pits.

Steve Krohn, 1060 Park Lane, stated that he received a notice of violation from the Evansville Police Department for an unlicensed vehicle that is on his property. He stated that he has gotten rid of thousands of dollars of items in order to come into code.

Mayor Hinds stated that this is an issue that Mr. Krohn needs to take up with the Municipal Court.

Bailey Wall, 1100 Cielo Vista, stated that he had an eagle project for the Boys Scouts that he would like to propose. He stated that he would like to propose a Lending Library and have it located by the bus stop at the Post Office.
