

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

March 26, 2018

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Phil Hinds at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Mayor Phil Hinds, Council Members Ernie Blackford, Jennifer Sorenson and Jory Delinger, Town Attorney Phil Willoughby, Public Works Director Dan Adcock, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Mayor Hinds led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Jennifer Sorenson to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting on March 12, 2018, were presented for approval. Motion was made by Jennifer Sorenson and seconded by Jory Delinger to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #3-2018: An Ordinance Modifying the Employee Handbook – Part-time Employee Definition. Third and final reading. Town Attorney Phil Willoughby summarized Ordinance #3-2018. Motion was made by Jory Delinger and seconded by Ernie Blackford to approve Ordinance #3-2018 on third and final reading. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSE: Business License application for ProTech Electric was presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Jennifer Sorenson to approve the business license for ProTech Electric. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: During public comments, Gene Williams stated that he would like to adopt a couple of trees and that one in particular is located in the area of First Street and Evans Street. He stated that there is a steel pipe next to the tree and that he would like permission to cut the pipe down.

Public Works Director Dan Adcock stated that he would take a look at the tree that he is talking about to see if it is in the Town right-of-way.

Gene Williams stated that he would like to know who owns the property located at Evans Street and Yellowstone Highway Frontage where the old tanks are located. He stated that some of the tanks were taken down some time ago, that he has not seen any activity for a long time, and that he feels the property is a nuisance.

Public Works Director Dan Adcock stated that last he knew, 71 Construction owned the property.


